



CAMBODIA DISCOVERED 2010

A comprehensive look into Cambodia including Phnom Penh with the notorious killing fields (optional – may be removed) and the great lake - Tonle Sap and Siem Reap with the amazing Angkor Temples

- Day 1 Arrive Phnom Penh where you will be met by your local English speaking guide for your transfer to your hotel.
- Day 2 After breakfast a morning city tour visits some of Cambodia's most remarkable sites including the National Museum, (B, L, D) Silver Pagoda, the Royal Palace, and Phnom Penh's oldest shrine, Wat Phnom. Lunch at a local restaurant then depart 12 km from the city to visit Tuol Sleng Museum and the Killing Fields.
NOTE: Some exhibits are graphic and may cause distress to some people.
A dinner at a local restaurant introduces the cuisine
- Day 3 After an early breakfast transfer to airport for flight (or wharf for boat service*) to Siem Reap. Upon arrival, transfer to (B, L, D) hotel for check in. Begin today's tour by entering the South Gate of Angkor Thom. Continue to the ruins of Bayon, Baphoun, the Royal Enclosure Phimeanakas and the Elephant terraces. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before visiting Angkor Wat and finishing with the sunset atop Bakheng Mountain. Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant.
- Day 4 After breakfast visit the Kravan Temple, Srah Srang, Banteay Kdei and the Prehak Khan Temple. Lunch at a local (B, L, D) restaurant before touring to see the floating village at Tonle Sap Lake – Cambodia's Great Lake. Dinner at a restaurant
- Day 5 A morning visit to Ta Promh and the Chau Say Tevoda Temple before lunch at a local restaurant.
(B, L) If time allows (subject to your departure flight) visit Baray and handicraft market before your transfer to Siem Reap airport for your departure.
