



Northern Thailand 2010

6-day Tour including the Golden triangle and hill-tribe visits

This tour showcases the magnificent ruins of Ayuthaya, the ancient city of Sukhothai, and the rose of the north, Chiang Mai. You'll see Elephants at work, hilltribe villages, home industries producing silk & handicrafts and explore magnificent temples.

Departures every Monday and Thursday from Bangkok

- Day 1 (L, D) Pick up from major Bangkok hotels and depart to Bang-Pa-In to visit the former Summer Palace, then continue to Ayuthaya to visit the ruins and temples with lunch at local restaurant. Continue to Lopburi to visit the temples and museum before proceeding to Pitsanuloke. Overnight with Dinner at Amarin Lagoon hotel.
- Day 2 (B, L, D) After Breakfast at hotel travel by bus to visit a private collection at the folklore museum before continuing to the ancient towns of Sukhothai and Sri Satchanalai, with Lunch enroute. Continue to overnight with Dinner at Lampang River Lodge.
- Day 3 (B, L, D) Continue by bus to Chiang Mai, with a visit to the White Karen hill tribes and Wat Haripoonchai in Lampoon Lunch en-route. After lunch visit the Home Industries Village at Bo Sang and San Kam Phaeng which is the center of hand-woven silk industries, traditional local products, antiques from Burma and hilltribe handicrafts, fine cotton and woodcarving. Overnight with dinner at Chiang Mai Plaza Hotel.
- Day 4 (B, L, D) Breakfast at the hotel. Visit an elephant training camp to see a demonstration of elephant at work (elephant ride is optional and not included in this program). Visit the orchid farm and lunch at local restaurant. In the afternoon, visit the one of most revered temples in Chiang Mai: Wat Doi Suthep, located high in the mountains, where you can enjoy a panoramic view of the whole Chiang Mai area. In the evening enjoy a Northern Thai Kantoke dinner with various shows and performances of hill tribes. Overnight at Chiang Mai Plaza Hotel.
- Day 5 (B, L, D) Breakfast at the hotel. Check out of the hotel. Enjoy the scenic ride to Thaton. Take an exciting long tail boat trip from Pha Tai to Chang Rai along the way and visit the various hill tribe villages. Lunch at Lanthong Restaurant. Proceed to visit the "Golden Triangle", the area where Thailand, Laos and Myanmar meet. Visit the historical city of Chiang Saen and continue to a small trading town of Mae Sai. Overnight with dinner at the Dusit Island Hotel.
- Day 6 (B, L) Breakfast at hotel. Check out of the hotel. Visit the local hill tribe village then transfer to Chiang Rai airport. A lunch box will be provided. Arrangements end or you can add your flight to Bangkok and a transfer will be provided
